Some are asymptomatic others were off anyway and had been waiting 3-4 days for texting. What they have done [REDACTED] primary care managers have come to centre to assist, they set up drive through swabbing at back of centre for all [REDACTED] off this am (after discussion with public health). The swabs are to get priority, as per public health. [REDACTED] They have enough PPEs and staff to cover over weekend. She herself is covering [REDACTED] over weekend. [REDACTED] The outbreak is confined to [REDACTED] at moment residents tested from other units have returned as negative [REDACTED] [REDACTED] has asked that when contact tracing is being done, can the caller first determine if the staff member is a healthcare worker and if they have no signs and symptoms can they advised to get texted first and then pending the result determine whether they need to go into self isolation for 14 days. She is concerned that if all her staff who have been in contact with residents and are asymptomatic she will have no staff left on duty.
