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HIQA judges the service to be compliant, substantially compliant, partially compliant or non-compliant with the standards. These are defined as follows:

- Compliant: A judgment of compliant means that on the basis of this inspection, the service is in compliance with the relevant national standard.
- Substantially compliant: A judgment of substantially compliant means that on the basis of this inspection, the service met most of the requirements of the relevant national standard, but some action is required to be fully compliant.
- Partially compliant: A judgment of partially compliant means that on the basis of this inspection, the service met some of the requirements of the relevant national standard while other requirements were not met. These deficiencies, while not currently presenting significant risks, may present moderate risks, which could lead to significant risks for people using the service over time if not addressed.
- Non-compliant: A judgment of non-compliant means that this inspection of the service has identified one or more findings, which indicate that the relevant national standard has not been met, and that this deficiency is such that it represents a significant risk to people using the service.
